**STALLS AVAILABLE**

Horses may arrive Friday afternoon to allow schooling Friday evening after 4:00 pm until dark.

A limited number of covered stalls will be available for \$35.00 per stall.

Please bring own shavings, water buckets, hay and feed.

Please clean stalls after use, otherwise a \$10.00 fee will be charged, thank you!!!

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. We offer an early entry fee - **\$15 per class if we receive your entries by 6 PM Wednesday** prior to the show, so that we can plan the show around you with the appropriate combination of equipment and personnel. After 6 PM Wednesday the regular entry fee of \$20 per class will apply to all e-mail entries and at the desk on show day. For the reduced fee, REGISTER EARLY! You will save money as well as help us produce a better show!
2. A \$20 show fee and \$15 grounds fee will be required for each horse/rider combination participating.
3. Please bring an open check to the horse show office to be closed out at the end of your horse showing day.
4. Chaps, paddock boots, and polo shirts are acceptable. Show coats are not required.
5. Riders must wear protective hard hats at all times while mounted. Please be sure use of tack (nose bands, bits, martingales, etc.) strictly adheres to USEF rules.
6. Horse/rider combinations may not cross-enter into divisions with more than 6" height difference. There is no restriction regarding horses with different riders cross-entering into divisions with more than 6" height difference.
7. Dogs must be on a leash held in hand at all times. Children do not have to be held on a leash but they must be supervised by an adult at all times.
8. Concessions will be available on the show grounds.
9. Classes with more than 14 entries will be split and two sets of ribbons will be awarded.
10. A fee of \$35.00 for schooling and for anyone not riding in the show.
11. USEF Rules to apply; however, elimination will occur after 3 (three) refusals. One courtesy fence will be allowed.
12. Stallions are not permitted on show grounds.
13. Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

## RELEASE INFORMATION

A release form for must be signed by each participant of legal age or by the parent/legal guardian of any minor for any show at Cedar Creek Run Stables.

*Trainers may NOT sign in lieu of parents, as this is a legal document.*

Please go to the website and download a form for each rider! Please bring signed forms to registration.

## COGGINS REQUIREMENTS

Texas law requires each show facility to obtain a current Coggins report for each horse admitted to the show grounds. This may be emailed prior to the show or brought to the show desk. Simply providing the Coggins number and date is not sufficient. We must verify that the Coggins is current and retain accurate records in the event we are audited. *Any horse arriving on Cedar Creek Run Stables property without a current Coggins will not be allowed on the property.*
